**MCLE Resolution No. 3, s. 2010**

In view of reports reaching the MCLE Office that certain court lawyers who resign from the court after having obtained their MCLE exemption, use said exemption in the practice of law, the MCLE Governing Board hereby resolves to impose the two-thirds (2/3) rule the applications for exemption of court lawyers so that the applicant must have served at least two years of the three-year compliance period provided under Bar Matter No. 850, before he/she may be issued a certificate of exemption.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
