RESOLUTION NO. 04-2005

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education (MCLE) Governing Board in its meeting on April 13, 2005, resolved that MCLE activities/programs shall be conducted by MCLE Providers for a maximum of nine (9) lecture hours per day, or a minimum of four (4) working days per week to cover the thirty-six (36) credit units MCLE requirement per compliance period in order not to overtax the participants or attendees in such seminars;

THEREFORE, the MCLE activities should be limited to not less than four (4) working days in a week, to complete the required thirty-six (36) credit units requirement at a maximum of nine (9) hours per day. No MCLE activity or program shall be held on a Sunday or legal holiday.

This resolution shall take effect immediately.
