MCLE GOVERNING BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 006-2013

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in A.M. No. 11-9-4-SC (Efficient Use of Paper Rule) ruled that there is a need to cut the judicial system's use of excessive quantities of costly paper, save our forest, avoid landslides, and mitigate the worsening effects of climate change that the world is experiencing;

WHEREAS, the Mandatory Continuing Legal Education Office (MCLEO) adheres to the same cause and principle.

WHEREFORE, in consonance with the Efficient Use of Paper Rule, the MCLE Governing Board hereby resolves that only three (3) copies of the following papers shall be filed, to wit:

- 1.) All applications for exemption from the MCLE;
- 2.) All applications for an education activity by the Providers;
- 3.) All applications for accreditation as MCLE Provider;
- 4.) All applications for participatory credit units based on the participation of the applicant and claim for non-participatory credit units.

The Provider's Report on the activity conducted shall be filed in only one (1) copy.
